

Exodus 19:1-6: “Who’s Voice Are You Listening To?”

FCF: God’s people are prone to listen to other voices and allow them to direct their lives.

1. “I have delivered you”

- God reminds them of their deliverance
 - v. 4 – “You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, how I bore you on eagles wings and brought you to myself.”

Notes:

Application: God’s deliverance is a call to *surrender* our lives and allow his voice to direct us.

2. “I have commissioned you”

- God commissions them to be a kingdom of priests
 - v. 6 – “and you will be for me a *kingdom of priests*...”

Notes:

Application: God’s commissioning is a call to *mediate* His character at all times, in every sphere of life

3. “I am with you”

- God’s presence with them makes them a holy nation
 - v. 6 – “and you will be for me a kingdom of priests and *holy nation*.”

Notes:

Application: God’s presence with us calls us to reflect his holiness to the world around us.
