The Reading of the Law

Westminster Shorter Catechism, 76–78

Leader: *What is the ninth commandment?*

Unison: The ninth commandment is, “You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.”

Leader: *What is required in the ninth commandment?*

Unison: The ninth commandment requires the maintaining and promoting of truth between man and man, and of our own and our neighbor’s good name, especially in witness-bearing.

Leader: *What is forbidden in the ninth commandment?*

Unison: The ninth commandment forbids whatsoever is prejudicial to truth, or injurious to our own, or our neighbor’s, good name.

The Corporate Prayer of Confession

Unison: Our Creator and Redeemer, your spoken word brings order, beauty, and light where there is chaos, emptiness, and darkness. We thank you for the power of your word in creating the world and in making us a new creation in Christ. We confess that our words are often riddled with falsehood, misrepresentation, and manipulation. Our lips lie and produce death rather than life, rivalry rather than friendship, and blame rather than repentance. We twist, distort, and dodge the truth in order to justify ourselves, protect our interests, or tear down others. Forgive us for our words that spread lifelessness and dishonor you. May the word of Christ dwell in us richly so that the words of our mouth and the meditations of our heart please you, our Rock and our Redeemer. In the name of Jesus Christ, Word made flesh, we pray. Amen.
