### DISCUSSION AND APPLICATION

- ❖ There is a great crowd and celebration as Jesus rides into Jerusalem. Does the crowd really understand who Jesus is? What are their expectations? Do you praise the Lord Jesus with the knowledge of who he is and why he has come?
- ❖ Why did the Pharisees fear Jesus so much? Does the authority and lordship of Jesus threaten you in any way? [*This is not an easy yes or no – take a close look at your heart and what it is you really fear.*] How is fear changed for those who are in Christ?
- ❖ How does our living after the resurrection of Jesus inform our understanding of this ride into Jerusalem? Of all the Scriptures?
