NOTES

DISCUSSION AND APPLICATION

- ♦ When the Lord says to Pharaoh, "Let my people go..." (v. 16), he is not giving the king of Egypt a suggestion or laying out options for him to consider. What is your general posture toward the Word of God when you hear it or read it? How does "...know that I am the LORD" (v. 17) inform this posture?
- Do you believe the Lord is the giver and sustainer of your life? What may you be looking to for life (physically, emotionally, spiritually) that distracts you or keeps you from worshipping the Life-giver?
- ❖ Can you identify a time when your sin has affected someone else? When someone else's sin(s) has affected you? Are you nursing sin right now that is affecting your family and the family of God?
- ♦ What is the condition of your prayer life? Do you have freedom in prayer? Do you approach the Lord with confidence and trust in his purposes?
- ♦ How are the strikes (plagues) against Egypt both a comfort and a warning? Who are they a comfort and a warning to?
