PARAMENTS

The Westminster Shorter Catechism states, "It is required of them that would worthily partake of the Lord's Supper, that they examine themselves of their knowledge to discern the Lord's body, of their faith to feed upon Him, of their repentance, love, and new obedience; lest, coming unworthily, they eat and drink judgment to themselves."

DISCUSSION AND APPLICATION

- ❖ When you talk about freedom or hear it discussed, what is the focus? What is usually being said? How does the Exodus inform our understanding of freedom?
- ❖ When temptation comes are you ready to run? What might this posture of readiness look like?
- ❖ Do you depend on the Lord's provision? How do you know? What makes this easy or difficult for you right now?
- ❖ "*Go, and serve the LORD.*" Where does the power to obey and serve the Lord come from? [Practice sharing this in a "safe" context for a while, it will help reinforce whether you believe it or not.]
