Let us therefore follow Paul's admonition in 1 Corinthians 11:27–29 to partake of the Lord's Supper in a worthy manner by examining ourselves before the Lord. The Westminster Shorter Catechism states, "It is required of them that would worthily partake of the Lord's Supper, that they examine themselves of their knowledge to discern the Lord's body, of their faith to feed upon Him, of their repentance, love, and new obedience; lest, coming unworthily, they eat and drink judgment to themselves."

DISCUSSION AND APPLICATION

- ❖ Does the reaction of the Israelites make sense when they see the Egyptian army coming towards them? Why or why not? We haven't heard a response like this from Moses before (v. 13). How can he respond this way now?
- ❖ Where is the real battle taking place here for the people? What does "standing firm" have to do with that battle? Who should the people be looking at in this situation? Why is those so important?
- ❖ Exodus 14 describes one of the most well-known events in the Bible. How would you use this story to explain our salvation in Christ?
