## **The Reading of the Law**

**Westminster Shorter Catechism, 45–47**

Leader: *What is the first commandment?*

Unison: The first commandment is, “You shall have no other gods before me.”

Leader: *What is required in the first commandment?*

Unison: The first commandment requires us to know and acknowledge God to be the only true God, and our God; and to worship and glorify him accordingly.

Leader: *What is forbidden in the first commandment?*

Unison: The first commandment forbids the denying, or not worshiping and glorifying, the true God as God, and our God; and the giving of that worship and glory to any other, which is due to him alone.

Unison: Out of the depths I cry to you, O LORD! O Lord, hear my voice! Let your ears be attentive to the voice of my pleas for mercy! If you, O LORD, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand?
