Westminster Shorter Catechism, 70–72

Leader: *What is the seventh commandment?*

Unison: The seventh commandment is, “You shall not commit adultery.”

Leader: *What is required in the seventh commandment?*

Unison: The seventh commandment requires the preservation of our own and our neighbor’s chastity, in heart, speech, and behavior.

Leader: *What is forbidden in the seventh commandment?*

Unison: The seventh commandment forbids all unchaste thoughts, words, and actions.

The Corporate Prayer of Confession

Unison: Father, God in heaven, you have told us that “blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.” Your own love for us demonstrates sacrifice of self for the sake of others, and yet we long to please ourselves at the cost of others. We treat human beings as objects to be used, rather than people to be loved. We constantly look for fulfillment in sexuality, instead of in our God, the giver of sex. We immerse our thoughts, our eyes, and our bodies in the lies of the world. We repent for using one of your gifts and making it the center of our existence. Give us fresh eyes that long to bring healing to the sexually skewed and broken of this world. Eyes that look to Jesus as the image of the invisible God. Flood our desires with the joy of your Son Jesus, so that the things of this world grow strangely dim. In Jesus’ Name, Amen.
