## **The Call to Confession**

**1 John 1:8–2:1**

Leader: *If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.*

## **The Corporate Prayer of Confession**

**Liturgical Forms and Prayers**

Unison: Our Father, we are sinful, and You are holy.

We recognize that we have heard in Your law difficult words, knowing how often we have offended You in thought, word, and deed, not only by obvious violations, but by failing to conform to its perfect commands, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone.

Apart from Christ, there is nothing in us that gives us reason for hope; for where we thought we were well, we are sick in soul. Where we thought we were holy, we are in truth unholy and ungrateful. Our hearts are filled with the love of the world; our minds are dark and are assailed by doubts; our wills are too often given to selfishness and our bodies to laziness and unrighteousness.

By sinning against our neighbors, we have also sinned against You, in whose image they were created.

In this time of silent confession, we bring You our particular sins.

## **The Individual Prayers of Confession**

### **The Assurance of Pardon**

**Galatians 4:4–7**

Leader: *When the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, “Abba! Father!” So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.*

Leader: *Jesus told his disciples, “If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.”*

## ✠ The Affirmation of Faith

The Apostles’ Creed

Leader: *Do you believe in God the Father?*

Unison: I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

Leader: *Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?*

Unison: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Leader: *Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?*

Unison: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic\* church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
