The Reading of the Law

Westminster Shorter Catechism, 49–51

Leader: *What is the second commandment?*

Unison: The second commandment is, “You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.”

Leader: *What is required in the second commandment?*

Unison: The second commandment requires the receiving, observing, and keeping pure and entire, all such religious worship and ordinances as God has appointed in his Word.

Leader: *What is forbidden in the second commandment?*

Unison: The second commandment forbids the worshipping of God by images, or any other way not appointed in his Word.

The Call to Confession

Psalms 19:7–10

Leader: *The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple; the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; the rules of the LORD are true, and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb.*

The Corporate Prayer of Confession

Unison: Your law is perfect, making wise the simple. In your law, you have provided for us clear guidance concerning how we are to worship you. Empower us to neither add nor subtract from your commands. Teach us to desire your commands more than fine gold and to consider your precepts sweeter than honey.
