Westminster Shorter Catechism, 76–78

Leader: *What is the ninth commandment?*

Unison: The ninth commandment is, “You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.”

Leader: *What is required in the ninth commandment?*

Unison: The ninth commandment requires the maintaining and promoting of truth between man and man, and of our own and our neighbor’s good name, especially in witness bearing.

Leader: *What is forbidden in the ninth commandment?*

Unison: The ninth commandment forbids whatsoever is prejudicial to truth, or injurious to our own, or our neighbor’s, good name.
